If you enjoy walking there are apps for your iPhone or Android Smart Phone that can enhance your pleasure by showing you routes to try, with maps, way marks and interesting information about places on the route.

If you walk to keep fit, there are apps to track a route that you take and record your distance, number of steps and how many calories you've used.

All the apps listed below use the signal from the GPS Satellites, so you will need to have Location turned on.
